HUNTER/JUMPER AWARDS PROGRAM RULES

The PShR celebrates the achievement of both the Horse and the Rider when they compete in **HUNTER/JUMPER** events. To be eligible, the horse must be registered with the PShR and the Owner and Rider must have paid membership dues to the PShR for the competition year. A Nomination Form for each horse/rider team must be submitted with appropriate fees postmarked at least 7 days prior to their first drive in order for scores to count. If the horse competes in more than one discipline, an additional fee must be paid for each discipline (e.g., a horse competing in Hunter/ Jumper and Endurance would have to be nominated for both disciplines).

The competition year will be from December 1 to November 30th of the following year. All results must be reported to the Awards Chair by December 10th and be accompanied by placing/results from an official source of a regional or national organization (e.g., results posted on the internet, a competition points sheet signed by the event manager, etc.). The horse/rider team must complete a minimum of two events to be eligible for points in the PShR Awards Program.

PShR awards are designed to reward horses that consistently earn good scores, regardless of where they place in a class. One CHAMPION and one RESERVE CHAMPION will be named for each division at each level of competition. Additional qualifying horse/rider teams will receive an Honorable Mention.

I. Hunter/Jumper Awards

- Divisions include Junior, Adult Amateur and Open
 - A Junior is anyone that has not reached his/her 18th birthday by December 1st of the competition year
 - Adult Amateurs are classified as anyone age 18 and above, who is not involved in any professional activities (see USEF rules for amateur status)
 - Hunter Divisions
 - Newcomer Walk/Trot Rider
 - Cross Rails
 - Short Stirrups
 - Children's Hunter Pony
 - Beginning Rider
 - Master Rider
 - Baby Green Hunter
 - Schooling Hunter
 - Low Hunter
 - Limit Hunter
 - Novice/Child Adult Hunter
 - Children's Hunter
 - Open Hunter
 - Hunter Derby
 - Jumper Divisions

- Beginner Jumper
- Intro/Nov Jumper
- Child/Adult Jumper

II. Scoring For Hunter/Jumper Awards Program

Points will be accumulated using the point system below. Riders are required to record and submit records for each competition. The standard point system for ribbons is:

1st- 7 points
2nd- 5 points
3rd- 4 points
4th- 3points
5th- 2 points
6th- 1 point

Add an additional two points for every placing at a recognized USEF or USHJA competition.
