LIMITED DISTANCE AWARDS PROGRAM RULES

The PShR celebrates the achievement of both the Horse and the Rider when they compete in **LIMITED DISTANCE** events. To be eligible, the horse must be registered with the PShR and the Owner and Rider must have paid membership dues to the PShR for the competition year. A Nomination Form for each horse/rider team must be submitted with appropriate fees postmarked at least 7 days prior to their first drive in order for scores to count. If the horse competes in more than one discipline, an additional fee must be paid for each discipline (e.g., a horse competing in Limited Distance and Endurance would have to be nominated for both disciplines).

The competition year will be from December 1 to November 30th of the following year. All results must be reported to the Awards Chair by December 10th and be accompanied by placing/results from an official source of a regional or national organization (e.g., results posted on the internet, a competition points sheet signed by the event manager, etc.). The horse/rider team must complete a minimum of two rides to be eligible for points in the PShR Awards Program.

I. LIMITED DISTANCE Riding Division

- a. Only rides sanctioned by the AERC will count toward PShR Limited Distance Awards. The horse/rider team must complete two rides.
 1. Champion and Reserve Champion Limited Distance PShR Horse & Senior Rider will be awarded at the end of each year. Additional qualifying horse/rider teams will receive an Honorable Mention.
 2. Champion and Reserve Champion Limited Distance PShR Horse & Junior Rider will be awarded at the end of each year. A Junior Rider is anyone under the age of 16 by December 1st of the competition year. Additional qualifying horse/rider teams will receive an Honorable Mention.

- b. Limited Distance rides must be between 25 and 35 miles in length. LD rides cannot exceed 35 miles in length.
- c. Mileage must be a multiple of five, ending in a 0 or 5, whichever is the nearest whole number to the actual ride mileage (example: 22.4 miles = 20 miles, 22.5 miles = 25 miles)
- d. More than one rider can ride the same horse for points with each horse/rider team accumulating separate points toward awards.

- e. Points will awarded per a Senior and Junior Division as per the Limited Distance Points Table (Section II)

Examples of formula:

- i. Rider places 2nd overall (20 points) on a 35-mile ride (17.5 points). Total of 47.5 points.
- ii. Rider completes (0 points) a 25-mile ride (12.5 points). Total of 12.5 points.

II. Limited Distance Points Table:
