MERITORIOUS SIRE and MERITORIOUS DAM AWARDS PROGRAM RULES

A goal of the Performance Shagya Registry (PSHR) is to produce horses with the ability to work in the discipline of a rider's choice and be an attentive companion. The Performance Shagya Registry (PSHR) Meritorious Sire and Meritorious Dam awards reward those stallions and mares producing such progeny registered with the PShR performing in formal competition and/or fulfilling non-competitive programs. To encourage the production of offspring and recognize the long-term contribution of all sires/dams, the second generation of grand-get will also contribute to the end of year award.

Progeny must be registered in the PShR for their points to count toward the Meritorious parent. Progeny can contribute points to both the sire and dam. Points will only be accumulated from the PShR Awards Programs.

All stallions and mares nominated for meritorious recognition must be registered with the PShR. The owner(s) must be members of the PShR during the year of the award and be in good standing. The sire/dam does not have to be shown. The stallion with the highest points at the end of the year will be awarded PShR Grand Champion Sire of the Year. Placing will be awarded to the top five scoring stallions. The mare with the highest points at the end of the year will be awarded PShR Grand Champion Dam of the Year. Placing will be awarded to the top five scoring mares.

ELIGIBILITY:

In order to qualify for a Performance Shagya Registry (PSHR) Meritorious Sire and/or Meritorious Dam Annual Award:

1. All horses participating must be registered with the PShR. This includes the stallion/mare and all the offspring contributing points to that sire/dam.
2. A nomination form must be submitted and one-time lifetime fee of \$25 for each sire/dam nominated in this awards program.
3. Owners agree to abide by the rules and regulations set forth by the shows they are attending and the rules of the PShR.
4. Submit all changes of horse ownership, transfers of ownership by US Mail to the PShR. Changes will be determined by date of postmark.
5. Points will be counted from December 1 to November 30th of the following year.

POINTS:

Points will be automatically accumulated from all progeny in the PShR Annual Awards program for each respective sire/dam.

Points from offspring of the sire/dam for the year-end individual categories will be awarded to the sire/dam as follows:

First Place	10 points	Champion Ambassador	10 points
Second Place	9 points	Champion Versatility	10 points
Third Place	8 points	Horses not placing in category but participated	2 points
Fourth Place	7 points		
Fifth place	6 points		
Sixth place	5 points		

Points from grand-get (second generation only) of the sire/dam for the year-end individual categories will be awarded to the sire/dam as follows:

First Place	6 points	Champion Ambassador	5 points
Second Place	5 points	Champion Versatility	5 points
Third Place	4 points	Horses not placing in category but participated	1 point
Fourth Place	3 points		
Fifth place	2 points		
Sixth Place	1 point
