

SHAGYA AMBASSADOR AWARDS PROGRAM RULES

The **PShR Shagya Ambassador Program** rewards Riders for every hour they spend with a PShR registered horse *in non-competitive activities*. To be eligible to receive year end awards the horse must be registered with the Performance Shagya-Arabian Registry. Additionally, Rider and Owner must have paid membership dues to the PShR for the competition year.

The competition year is from December 1 to November 30th of the following year (year used to identify the period of competition). All nominations, with appropriate fees, must be sent to the PShR Treasurer by December 10th. Payment for nominations can be made either through check or by PayPal to performanceshagya@gmail.com. All results must be reported to the Awards Chair by December 10th and be accompanied by placing/results from an official source of a regional or national organization (e.g., results posted on the internet, a competition points sheet signed by the event manager, etc.). The horse/rider team must complete a minimum of two events to be eligible for points in the PShR Awards Program.

1. Registration and Eligibility

- The Rider must be a member in good standing of the PShR at the time of participation in the activity.
- The Horse(s) ridden for Shagya Ambassador Program activities must be registered with the Performance Shagya Registry.
- Program participants are defined as an individual RIDER, not a specific horse and rider combination. This
 means that as a Rider, you may ride any number of horses, regardless of whether you own them or not, as
 long as they are registered with the PShR.
- There will be two (2) divisions by age in this program: **JUNIOR** (A rider that has not reached his/her 18th birthday by December 1st of the competition year) and **SENIOR**.

II. Qualifying Activities

 The Shagya Ambassador Program will award points for any activity with a PShR registered horse, as long as the participant is <u>RIDING</u> the horse.

Examples of recognized activities:

Trail Rides Clinics

Parades Pleasure Riding
Demonstrations Pleasure Driving
Horse Fairs Riding/Driving Lessons

Arena Work Pony Club of America Non-Competitive Riding Events

4-H Non-Competitive Riding Events

Examples of activities that are **not** recognized:

Ground Work Grooming, Feeding, Barn Chores

Tacking Horse Transportation

Any competitive activity or an activity receiving monetary remuneration

III. Points, Milestones and Awards

- Points are awarded 1:1 with hours, one point awarded for each hour of participation.
- Three awards are made annually based on total points, as follows:

High Point – Junior High Point – Senior
