

SPORT HORSE IN-HAND AWARDS PROGRAM RULES

The PShR celebrates the achievement of both the Horse and the Handler when they compete in **SPORT HORSE IN-HAND** events. To be eligible to receive year end awards the horse must be registered with the Performance Shagya-Arabian Registry. Additionally, Rider and Owner must have paid membership dues to the PShR for the competition year.

The competition year is from December 1 to November 30th of the following year (year used to identify the period of competition). All nominations, with appropriate fees, must be sent to PShR by December 10th. Payment for nominations can be made either through check or by PayPal to performanceshagya@gmail.com. All results must be reported to PShR by December 10th and be accompanied by placing/results from an official source of a regional or national organization (e.g., results posted on the internet, a competition points sheet signed by the event manager, etc.). The horse/rider team must complete a minimum of two events to be eligible for points in the PShR Awards Program.

Halter Awards

- Divisions include Junior, Adult Amateur and Open.
 - A Junior is anyone that has not reached his/her 18th birthday by December 1st of the competition year.
 - Adult Amateurs are classified as anyone age 18 and above, who is not involved in any professional activities (see USEF rules for amateur status).
- Awards will be given to horses in age divisions: 2 & under, 5 & under, age 5 and up. Only one
 age class per horse (e.g., a horse/handler team cannot be entered in both 2 and under and 5 &
 under).
- More than one handler can show the same horse for points with each horse/handler team accumulating separate points toward awards for each handler's division.

Qualifications for Halter Awards Program

- For Junior, Adult Amateur and Open handler awards, results from Schooling/Open and Rated shows will count. A copy of the show bill or other verification of the show date must be included when sending results of Schooling/Open shows.
- The following are eligible classes: Open Halter classes, Breed-Restricted classes, Championship classes, Showmanship classes, Get of Dam/Sire classes, In-hand Trail classes (if applicable). At Liberty classes are not eligible.
