

PSHR POLICY FOR THE PLACEMENT OF LICENSED STALLIONS OR MARES FROM OTHER ISG REGISTRIES INTO THE PSHR

Shagya-Arabian Stallions and Mares registered with a recognized ISG registry seeking entry into the Performance Shagya-Arabian Registry must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1) Said stallion or mare must be in good standing with a recognized ISG registry.
- 2) Said stallion or mare must have completed all requirements and provide complete documentation including but not limited to:
 - a) Verification of the Book standing from a recognized ISG registry.
 - b) Copy of the birth certificate or registration certificate from a recognized ISG registry.
 - c) Copy of all Inspection and Performance Test scores and comments.
 - d) Copy of DNA or Bloodtyping. Test results must be applicable by the Genetics Laboratory used by the PShR. If the results are not applicable, a new DNA test must be completed at the Genetics Laboratory used by the PShR at the expense of the owner.
 - e) Verification of the current owner from a recognized ISG registry.
 - f) The Performance Shagya-Arabian Registry may ask for additional documentation that is deemed necessary.
- 3) The fee for permanent entry into a PShR studbook is \$300.00.
- 4) The owner of the stallion must be a member of the PShR in the year a mare is bred by their stallion and in the year progeny are born by their stallion.
 - a) This fee may be paid by anyone on behalf of the stallion owner.
