

PSHR POLICY FOR THE USE OF FROZEN SEMEN OR EMBRYO TRANSFER

General Requirements:

- 1) The donating mare or stallion must be registered with the PShR
- 2) If the donating mare or stallion belongs to a recognized ISG registry other than the PShR, the registration of stallion or mare is outlined in the **PSHR POLICY FOR LICENSING FOR STALLIONS OR MARES FROM OTHER ISG REGISTRIES.**
- 3) Use of frozen semen is outlined in the **ISG POLICY FOR THE USE OF FROZEN SEMEN**
- 4) Use of frozen embryo's or eggs will abide by the same guidelines as documented for frozen semen in the **ISG POLICY FOR THE USE OF FROZEN SEMEN**
- 5) The mare owner must report any pregnancy resulting from the use of frozen semen, frozen embryos, or frozen eggs during the calendar year to the PShR Registrar along with a \$50 transaction fee.
- 6) A mare owner with a mare bred using frozen semen, frozen embryos, or frozen eggs must be a member of the PShR during the calendar of the breeding or the transaction fee will be doubled.
- 7) If the bred mare is leased, a written copy of the lease agreement signed by the recorded mare owner and the lessee must be on file with the PShR Registrar by the end of the calendar year of the breeding.
