



PSHR Breeding Summary for Shagya-Arabian Stallions

PSHR Breeding Guidelines – ZBO

This is meant to be a high level summary for the PShR Stallion Books.

Please refer to the PShR Breeding Guidelines available on the PShR Breeding Guidelines page of the website for complete details and guidelines.

Stallion Book I

1. Stallion must have seven (7) or more registered Shagya-Arabians in the 4th generation
2. Both parents are Book I Shagya-Arabians OR
3. One parent may be a purebred Arabian, if that horse meets the PShR Breeding guidelines
4. Stallion must receive a minimum average inspection score of seven (7) at an ISG affiliated inspection
5. Stallion must be performance tested for permanent placement in Book I. Basic requirements are equal to the "Specialty" requirements

Stallion Book I Appendix (Book IA)

1. Stallion with less than seven (7) Shagya-Arabians in the 4th generation
2. Stallion must receive a minimum average inspection score of seven (7) at an ISG affiliated inspection
3. Stallion must be performance tested for permanent placement in Book I. Basic requirements are equal to the "Specialty" requirement
4. Purebred Arabian Stallions are eligible if the horse meets the PShR Breeding Guidelines. See the Breeding Guidelines Page on the PShR Website for full details

Stallion Book II

1. Stallion with seven (7) or more Shagya-Arabians in the 4th generation
2. Stallion had an average inspection score less than seven (7) at an ISG affiliated inspection OR
3. No Stallion Performance Test

Stallion Book II Appendix (Book IIA)

1. Stallion with less than seven (7) Shagya-Arabians in the 4th generation
2. Stallion had an average inspection score less than seven (7) at an ISG affiliated inspection OR
3. No Stallion Performance Test
