Shagya-Arabian Stallion Studbook I

- 1. Both parents must be Book I ShA registered and approved for ShA breeding by an ISG recognized commission. (PShR & ISG)
- 2. Sire, grandsires and great-grandsires must be ShA-Book registered. (ISG)
- 3. The 4th generation must have seven (7) or more ShA's out of the 16 ancestors. The remaining ancestors must be Arabian recognized by WAHO.
- Upon inspection a stallion must obtain a minimum average score of seven (7). (PShR & ISG)
- 5. To be permanently recorded in Book I Performance Testing must be completed as a stallion within 3 years. ISG minimum performance requirements at ISG-RZBO- 2.1.4. PShR performance requirements in PShR-ZBO breeding guidelines.
- 6. Three (3) years of age or older stallions will be registered in the stallion book categories. (ISG & PShR)
- 7. A veterinary examination must be submitted indicating the horse is free of any anomalies or other genetic dispositions.
- 8. At the time of registration the stallion must be a height of 154cm (ISG-RZBO-2.1.3)
- 9. Must have a valid DNA test on file. (ISG & PShR)
- 10. ShA pedigrees must trace back to an origin of the state and private Austro-Hungarian studs. Only WAHO recognized Purebred Arabians are allowed in a Shagya pedigree. (ISG & PShR)
- 11. Cannot have sired more than three (3) individuals before completing performace test. (ISG & PShR)
- 12. Owner of the horse and parents are members of an ISG-recognized breeding association in good standing. (ISG)

Shagya-Arabian Stallion Studbook II

- 1. The 4th generation must have seven (7) or more ShA's out of the 16 ancestors. The remaining ancestors must be Arabian recognized by WAHO. (ISG & PShR)
- 2. Stallions less than 154 cm (Less than 15.1 hands) (ISG)
- 3. Upon inspection a stallion has a minimum average score of less than seven (7). (ISG & PShR)
- 4. One or Both parents not ShA-Book I registered. (ISG)
- 5. One or more of sire, grandsires and great-grandsires not ShA Book I (ISG)
- 6. Sire is a ShA Book II stallion approved for breeding.
- 7. Performance Testing has not been completed or passed. Must be completed within 3 years. ISG minimum performance ISG-RZBO- 2.1.4.
- 8. ShA dam is a ShA Studbook II mare approved for breeding. (ISG)
- **All remaining points in ShA stallion Studbook I must be completed.

Shagya-Arabian Stallion Studbook I Appendix (Book IA)

1. Horses with less than seven (7) ShA horses in the 4th generation. The remaining ancestors must be Purebred Arabian (WAHO).

ShA in 4th generation

2. Purebred Arabian Stallions with pedigrees recognized by the World Arabian Horse Association (WAHO)

Meets all Book I points 3. All remaining ShA stallion Studbook I requirements apply.

Shagya-Arabian Mare Book I

- 1. The 4th generation must have seven (7) or more ShA's out of the 16 ancestors. The remaining ancestors must be purebred Arabian recognized by WAHO. (ISG & PShR)
- 2. Both parents are Book I Shagya-Arabian or
- 2A. Either parent may be a purebred WAHO purebred Arabian approved for Shagya breeding.
- Dams can be ISG-RZBO Mare Book II or Mare Book IA if the sire of the mare being placed in the ISG Studbooks is a Book I ShA stallion approved for breeding.
- 4. Upon inspection a mare must obtain a minimum average score of seven (7) (PShR). Inspection average a minimum of six (6) and *cannot receive an individual score of five (5) or less. (ISG)*
- 5. Mares must complete PShR Mandatory testing and Performance test. Refer to complete Breeding Guidelines for details. (PShR)
- 6. Three (3) year old and older mares will be registered in their studbook category.
- 7. ShA pedigrees must trace back to an origin of the state and private Austro-Hungarian studs. (ISG & PShR)
- **Refer to complete PShR Breeding Guidelines for Mare Grandfather Clause.

Shagya-Arabian Mare Book II

- 1.The 4th generation must have seven (7) or more ShA's out of the 16 ancestors. The remaining ancestors must be purebred Arabian recognized by WAHO. (ISG & PShR)
- 2. Upon inspection a mare has a minimum average score of less than seven (7). (PShR) Less than minimum average of six (6). (ISG)
- 3. Sire is a ShA Book II stallion approved for breeding.
- 4. ShA dam is a ShA Studbook II mare approved for breeding.
- **All remaining points in ShA Mare Studbook I must be completed.

Shagya-Arabian Mare Book I Appendix (Book IA)

Horses with less than seven (7) ShA horses in the 4th generation. The remaining ancestors must be Purebred Arabian (WAHO).

- Purebred Arabian Mares with pedigrees recognized by the World Arabian Horse Association (WAHO) approved for Shagya breeding.
- 3. Purebred Arabian mares must have the same performance requirements as apply to the ShA.
- Meets all remaining ShA Mare Studbook I requirements.

Less than 7 ShA in the 4th generation or a Purebred Arabian but does not meet other

Shagya-Arabian Mare Book II Appendix (Book IIA)

- Horses with less than seven (7) ShA horses in the 4th generation. The remaining ancestors must be Arabian recognized by WAHO.
- Purebred Arabian Mares with pedigrees recognized by WAHO.
- **All remaining points in ShA Mare Studbook Il must be completed.

Less than 7 ShA in 4th generation

Meets all Book I points
