# Performance Shagya-Arabian Registry Annual meeting April 11, 2018

Members present for call: Lucy Stafford, John Stafford, Nicole Mauser-Storer, Marty Power, Holly Haddenham, Linda Rudolphi, Kathy Voyer, Anke Brander, Donna Coss, Tera McCool and Sherry Aune.

708pm central time meeting was called to order.

Treasurer's Report: presented by Kathy prepared by Treasurer Holly Kemmis. \$5719.00 in the account. There are 2 regular and primary sources of income for the registry. They are dues and registration fees. A budget was approved for the Distance Nationals at the March meeting. The budget includes 1 year of trophies and purchasing 3 years of ribbons, to receive a discounted price.

#### 2017 accomplishments

- \*Published 2 newsletters, spring and winter. Holly H. asks for more news and pictures to include in the newsletters.
- \* PShr promotion- 5 press releases went out and were picked up by places like endueance.net and other magazines. We did not renew American horse publications for 2018. Nicole asks for more ideas and content to be included in future press releases.
- \*Kathy talked about Facebook promotion. At the beginning of the year we had a lot of response to paid Facebook advertising with the reach extending to many other countries that are actively breeding Shagya- Arabian horses, but Facebook changed its algorithm to allow for only organic reach to friends only. We will continue to use Facebook to promote our activities. Donna added that she has a Facebook page called Shagya international that we are welcome to post on as well. Donna asks if all the horse we post about have to be PShR registered and if people have to be members. Lucy said that there is no formal policy and that all are welcome.
- \*Inspection Report. Given by Marty. We held an inspection in the fall. The breakdown of horses inspected is as follows: 1 ShA mare, 1 Arab Mare, 4 ShA sporthorses, and 2 ShA geldings. 2 horses completed specialty Plus. Marty said she learned it was possible for us to put on a small inspection and break even. We used 1 local judge and 1 international judge. There was not a lot of monetary savings using the local judge but it gave us more local promotion and recognition.
- \* In 2017 a MOU was signed with the Arabian Horse association to be a part of Distance Nationals for the next 3 years.
- \* Membership Report was given by Linda. So far for 2018 we have 28 paid members. In 2017 we had 39 members. In 2016 we had the highest ever membership with 49. Linda expects this year's numbers to go up as the show season starts.
- \* Registry Report given by Linda. There are 129 horses registered in PShR. We have had about 13 foals born including sporthorses since the beginning of the registry. Worldwide there was an estimated 234 foals born. Linda designed new registration certificates.

Anke asked about some trouble she is having using the PayPal account. If you use the performanceshagya.com you should be able to send any amount.

### New business

The Endurance Nationals are going be held in Henryville Indiana on October 25-28 2018. Other breeds partnering with AHA are Appaloosa, Paso Fino and Morgan. If your horse is registered half Arab you can compete as half Arab as well.

2018 will bring new committees and committee chair persons. The first committee will be for the west coast inspections.

748pm Lucy concludes the formal business and opens the floor to discussion.

There is discussion on upcoming show and events many members are headed to the WEG trials soon. Donna asks about combing the inspections with other registries. Discussion followed about the different inspection requirements used by each Shagya registry.
