COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE AWARDS PROGRAM RULES

The PShR celebrates the achievement of both the Horse and the Rider when they compete in **COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDING** events. To be eligible, the Rider and his/her Horse(s) must be members in good standing with the PShR and must submit an Application Form with appropriate fees that is postmarked at least 7 days prior to their first ride in order for scores to count. The competition year will be the calendar year of January 1 to December 31.

All competitions must be approved events, recognized by a national organization, with mandatory veterinary supervision. The American Endurance Ride Conference (AERC), Upper Midwest Endurance Competitive & Endurance Ride Assoc. (UMECRA), North American Trail Ride Conference (NATRC), and Arabian Horse Association (AHA) are examples of approved ride sanctioning organizations. If a rider is in doubt of the sanctioning organization, please contact the PShR Award Chairperson for clarification before the event.

The rider must be a Member in good standing of the Performance Shagya Registry (have a current membership) at the time of the competition. The program participant is defined as the individual HORSE, not a specific Horse and Rider combination. A fee of \$10.00 for each division entered must be paid to be eligible for championships. If the horse competes in more than one division, an additional fee of \$10.00 for each must be paid for each division. For example, a horse competing in Competitive Trail Riding and Endurance would have to nominate for both divisions.

Endurance, Limited Distance and Competitive Riding and Competitive Driving will be awarded separately. In addition, a Senior and Junior rider will be awarded in each division. A Junior is anyone that has not reached his/her 18th birthday by January 1 of the award year. A horse must complete the ride and pass any veterinary exams to be eligible for PShR points.

A copy of the competition flyer or some form of published information must be sent to the Awards Chairperson within 45 days of the event. The results/placing from the event must be either from the intranet or from a competition point sheet signed by event management.

I. Competitive Trail Riding:

- a. Competitive Trail Riding differs from endurance riding since competitive events have several different sanctioning organizations across the USA.
- b. Only rides sanctioned by a national organization will count toward PShR High Point Competitive Riding Awards
 1. PShR Champion and Reserve Champion Competitive Riding Horse – Senior Rider, will be awarded at the end of each year. The top six (6) horses will be placed and recognized.
 2. PShR Champion and Reserve Champion Competitive Riding Horse – Junior Rider, will be awarded at the end of each year. The top six (6) horses will be placed and recognized.

- c. Points will be awarded on placing per weight division. At AHA Regional or National rides where weight divisions are not available – points will be awarded per overall placing and bonus points will be awarded for regional and national competition.
- d. Competitive rides & drives novice rides will be recognized.
- e. Mileage must be a multiple of five (5), ending in zero (0) or five (5), whichever is the nearest whole number to the actual ride mileage. (example: 22.4 miles = 20 miles, 22.5 miles = 25 miles)
- f. More than one rider can ride/drive the nominated horse for points
- g. Points will be awarded for a Senior and Junior Division as per the Competitive Points Table (VIII).
Examples of formula:
 1. Rider places 2nd (20 points) on a 12.5-mile novice ride (6.25 points). Total of 26.25 points.
 2. Rider places 3rd (15 points) on a 50 mile (25 point) Regional ride (13 points). Total of 53 points.
