DRESSAGE Awards Program Rules

The PShR celebrates the achievement of a horse and rider combination in Dressage. To be eligible, the Owner, Rider and Horse must be registered members in good standing with the PShR. He/She must submit an Application Form with appropriate fees postmarked at least 7 days prior to the first show in order for scores to count. All registration fees are for the calendar year beginning Jan 1st and ending Dec 31st.

PShR awards are designed to reward horses that consistently earn good scores, regardless of where they place in a class. One CHAMPION and one RESERVE CHAMPION will be named for each division at each level of competition, Introductory through FEI. One CHAMPION and one RESERVE CHAMPION will be given for Musical Freestyle at First through FEI levels combined.

I. Dressage Awards

- Divisions include Junior (Young Rider), Open and Adult Amateur. A Junior (Young Rider) is anyone that has not reached his/her 22nd birthday by January 1st of the award year.
- Levels are Introductory through Grand Prix and Musical Freestyle.
- Adult Amateurs must have an US Equestrian Federation (USEF) Amateur card.
- *Maiden Award Ribbons* will be given in each division for horses in their first year of showing at Training Level through Grand Prix at any USDF/USEF recognized show.

II. Registration and Eligibility

- The Rider and Owner of the horse must be members in good standing of the PShR at the time scores are obtained.
- Dressage Awards Program entries for each horse and rider combination must be postmarked at least seven (7) days prior to the first show from which they plan to submit scores.
- A fee of **\$10.00** for each level must be paid for each horse and rider combination to be eligible for championships. If the horse and rider combination competes in more than one division, an additional fee of **\$10.00** for each level must be paid.
- The Awards Chairperson must be notified in writing and all fees paid if adding a level or division later in the year. All registrations are for the show year **January 1 through December 31**.

III. Qualification For Dressage Awards Program

- The Horse and Rider combination must have three qualifying scores from three different judges from two different shows. NOTE: When all three qualifying scores were earned at recognized schooling shows, the

scores must be from three different shows.

- Scores must be a minimum of 60% at Training – 4th level and a minimum of 58% at PSG and above.
- Scores must be from USEF, FEI or USDF tests. The scores will be averaged.
- Scores must be earned at USEF/USDF recognized shows, open to all breeds. One test score must be from the highest test for the level (e.g. Training Test 4).
- Scores for the Maiden Award may be from any test for the level.
- The rider must send to the Award Chairperson either the horse's USDF Score Sheet with their three chosen scores highlighted or a "GOOD QUALITY" photocopy of the original test for each qualifying score. Photocopy must clearly state the show name, horse and rider, class, date, judge, score and judges signature. Photocopy does not have to include individual movement scores and comments.
- Scores must be postmarked on or before December 15.
