MERITORIOUS SIRE & MERITORIOUS DAM

A goal of the Performance Shagya Registry (PSHR) is to produce horses with the ability to work in the discipline of a riders' choice and be an attentive companion. The Performance Shagya Registry (PSHR) Meritorious Sire and Meritorious Dam Award recognizes those stallions and mares producing such progeny registered with the PShR performing in formal competition and/or participating in non-competitive programs. To encourage the production of offspring and recognize the long-term contribution of all sires/dams, the second generation of grand-get will also contribute to the end-of-year award Meritorious Award.

Progeny must be registered in the PShR for their points to count toward the Meritorious parent. Progeny can contribute points to both the sire and to the dam. Points will only be accumulated from the PShR annual awards program in all the PShR Awards Divisions.

All stallions and mares nominated for Meritorious recognition must be registered with the PShR. The owner(s) must be members of the PShR during the year of the award and be in good standing. The sire and/or dam does not have to be shown.

Meritorious champion and placings through Top Ten will be awarded for the annual Meritorious Sire and the annual Meritorious Dam.

Nomination Procedure:

- A nomination form must be submitted and a one-time lifetime fee of \$25 for each nominated sire/dam must be on file with the Awards Chairperson before points can be counted. The postmark date of the payment will determine the date points begin to accumulate.
- Points will be counted from January 1 to December 31 each year.
- A nomination form and fee must be mailed to the PShR at least seven (7) days before the first show.
- Any changes of ownership must be recorded with the Awards Chairperson.

Points:

- Points will automatically accumulate from all progeny and grand-get participating in the PShR Annual Awards program for each respective sire/dam.
- Points from the progeny and grand-get of a nominated sire/dam will be awarded to the Meritorious division based on the annual year end placings in the PShR Award program.
- Grand-get only extends to the second generation of the nominated sire/dam.
- The Sire/Dam is eligible to receive a Meritorious Award up to and including the year of his/her death.
