SHAGYA AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The **PSHR Shagya Ambassador Program** rewards Riders for every hour they spend with a PShR registered horse in Non-Competitive activities. To be eligible, the Rider must be a member in good standing with PShR and must submit an Application Form with appropriate fee, postmarked at least 7 days prior to their first activity in order for points to be awarded. Each horse ridden for these activities must be registered with the PShR. All registration fees are for the calendar year beginning January 1 and ending December 31.

1. Registration and Eligibility

- The Rider must be a member in good standing of the PShR at the time of participation in the activity.
- The Horse(s) ridden for Shagya Ambassador Program activities must be registered with the Performance Shagya Registry.
- Program participants are defined as an individual RIDER, not a specific horse and rider combination. This means that as a Rider, you may ride any number of horses, regardless of whether you own them or not, as long as they are registered with the PShR.
- Registration for the Rider must be postmarked at least seven (7) days prior to the first activity for which they wish to receive points.
- A fee of **\$10.00** must be paid for each Rider to be eligible to receive an award in the Shagya Ambassador Program.
- All registrations are for the calendar year **January 1 through December 31** and must be renewed annually.
- There will be two (2) divisions by age in this program: **JUNIOR** (A rider that has not reached his/her 22nd birthday by January 1st of the program year) and **SENIOR**.
- A third award will be made in this program: **TRAIL MASTER** (no age divisions) will be given to the rider with the most hours on the trail, driving, riding or a combination thereof.

II. Qualifying Activities

- The Shagya Ambassador Program will award points for any activity with a PShR registered horse, as long as the participant is **RIDING** the horse.

Examples of recognized activities:

Trail Rides	Clinics
Parades	Schooling Shows
Demonstrations	Pleasure Riding
Horse Fairs	Pleasure Driving
Arena Work	Riding/Driving Lessons
4-H Non-Competitive Riding Events	Pony Club of America Non-Competitive Riding Events

Examples of activities that are **not** recognized:

Ground Work
Tacking

Grooming, Feeding, Barn Chores
Horse Transportation

III. Points, Milestones and Awards

- Points are awarded 1:1 with hours, one point awarded for each hour of participation.
- The Shagya Ambassador Program runs continuously, meaning points for activities are accumulated for the Rider over his/her lifetime. When a new year begins, the Rider must register with the program for his/her points count from the prior year(s) to be carried over.
- Three awards are made annually based on total points, as follows:

High Point – Junior

High Point – Senior

Trail Master – Open
